General School Uniform

- Plain navy or logo sweatshirt or cardigan
- White or pale blue polo shirt
- Black or grey trousers, skirt, shorts or culottes (<u>no leggings or cycling shorts</u>). Skirts/shorts should be fingertip length (a student should be able to stand straight, arms by their side, and not have their fingertips reach past their skirt/shorts).
- In summer blue and white gingham dresses may be worn
- Sensible black shoes (no sandals or flip flops)

Jewellery

Children with pierced ears may wear studs (or very small sleepers) only. Watches have to be removed for PE and are the wearer's responsibility. Watches or ear-rings must not be worn the day the class goes swimming. **No other jewellery is allowed, including nose and lip piercings etc.**

Nail varnish / makeup / tattoos

Nail varnish, makeup or tattoos are **not allowed** in school. This includes acrylic and gel nails.

Shoes

Shoes must be completely black in colour and appropriate for a normal day at school. Children like to run around at break-times and therefore high heels or open sandals are not suitable as accidents can occur more easily. Platform or high-top trainers are not appropriate.

<u>Hair</u>

Whilst at school, we encourage you to tie long hair back for safety and hygiene reasons. We ask parents/carers to ensure that their child has a hairstyle that is suitable for school. **Extreme hairstyles, such as outlandish colours or cuts, for boys or girls, are not suitable for school.** If you are unsure, please seek advice from the Headteacher first.
