Late applications won't be processed until after 1 March 2023, by which time many schools will be full and you are much less likely to be offered a place at your preferred school.

The Friends of Exhall Juniors are a group of parents who organise fun events for the children and the school community throughout the year and raise money for the school.



#### **Poppy Playtime**

Some of you may be aware and recall a previous mention of an online game called Poppy Playtime involving a character called Huggy Wuggy.

The game was released last year but is still very much present online and on social media sites, such as YouTube and TikTok. As well as the character being quite visually disturbing, the content within this game is frightening and not age-appropriate. The recent creation of plush toys have made this character seem appealing and the names of the characters involved could cause parental controls to not recognize the worrying content of the game or videos related to it. New updates have included characters such as "Mommy Long Legs" and "Kissy Missy" have also added appeal to vulnerable users. Our vigilance together around what our

children are viewing online is vital in ensuring they are safe online.

#### **Attendance**

At Exhall Junior School we place great importance on good attendance and punctuality.

We know that a child's attendance has a direct impact on their learning. Those children who are regularly absent from school and regularly late do not achieve their potential and do fall behind in class. Please support the school in this by ensuring that your child attends school regularly and arrives ready to learn and on time.

#### **Authorised Absences**

These are mornings or afternoons away from school for a valid reason such as illness, emergency medical or dental appointments (routine appointments should always be made out of school hours) and emergencies.

#### **Unauthorised Absences**

An absence is classified as Unauthorised if the reason was not recognised as acceptable. The Department for Education (DfE) and Local Education Authorities provide information for schools as to what is acceptable and what is not. Examples of reasons that would **not be accepted**:

A birthday Got up too late to come in A shopping trip Sibling off

Friday/ Monday off to go on weekend breaks

#### **Attendance Monitoring**

As attendance and punctuality is so important to us, we cannot be complacent where there are instances of unacceptable, low pupil attendance, or if pupils are regularly late to school.

The Local Authority is keen that we adopt measures and involve external agencies if the level of attendance requires us to do so when attendance is below 90%.

If there is not an improvement in attendance then you may be asked to come into school for a formal meeting to discuss the matter further.

# Continued unauthorised absences could then result in a penalty notice being issued.

The school will be moving to a County monitoring system soon when all unauthorised holidays will be logged and actions will result.




